ORDER ON THE DEFENDANTS' MOTION IN LIMINE
TO EXCLUDE TESTIMONY OF JULIE A. MOORE

The defendants' motion is denied. The court finds that an expert witness would aid the jury in determining facts regarding the defendants' investigation of the plaintiff. Investigative practices within the world of corporate employment are not a matter of common knowledge. Further, some of the defendants' witnesses and some of the defendants are highly experienced and educated in the field. Practically speaking, it is difficult to believe that part of their testimony will not consist of opinion evidence gathered from their own professional education and experience. The jury is entitled to an independent view from another witness with substantial education and experience. The range of the expert witness's testimony may be limited by the court depending upon the issues and progress of the actual trial.
